CCL is currently planning to undertake compliance and safety upgrades to the lifts in Wentworth, Selborne & Lockhart Chambers. The compliance and safety upgrades are necessary and need to be completed as soon as possible.

Unfortunately, this work will involve every lift in the above buildings being out of service for approximately 1.5 weeks each. CCL is endeavouring to have the majority of this work undertaken during the December 19/January 20 legal vacation period however, we believe that the lift industry also have a shutdown during this period so resourcing this project at that time may be difficult.

The final schedule for the works will be developed and circulated over coming months, however the intention is to provide continuous access to all Floors at all times and compress as much work as possible into the last week of December 2019 and first two weeks of January 2020.

This work will not improve lift performance and relates solely to necessary compliance upgrades.
