

Exclusion zone in Martin Place, Phillip Street and Macquarie Street

There is a police operation underway in Martin Place, Phillip Street and Macquarie Street due to a gas leak. The details are not entirely clear at the moment, however it is understood that pedestrian and vehicular traffic is completely restricted in Phillip and Macquarie Streets, from Hyde Park to Hunter Street. Construction around Castlereagh Street is the likely cause of the incident.

The information received thus far suggests that an exclusion zone is being established in the area.

Fire & Rescue along with the gas utility company Jemena continue to work in the vicinity and some closures remain in place for Elizabeth and Castlereagh Streets.

Martin Place train station remains closed.
