

Circular to Clerks: Cabling installation

Telstra have notified CCL of their intention to upgrade the mobile network repeaters in Wentworth & Selborne Chambers, to provide 4G Network services for Telstra customers.

In order to deliver this service a cable must be installed to transmit the signal from the Telstra Network pit in Phillip Street to the roof of Selborne Chambers, where the new equipment will be installed. The cable is scheduled to be installed early each morning throughout next week, and the areas that will be affected by the installation are:

- the basement, from Wentworth to Selborne;
- the Selborne Chambers comms and electrical riser which is located adjacent the lifts, on all Floors from basement to Level 13; and,
- the Selborne Chambers roof.

Other than some drilling that may be required on the roof during the final stages of the cabling installation, the work is not anticipated to have adverse impact on Members, however to minimise disruption, it has been scheduled to be carried out early each morning next week.

At this stage further information about the completion of the upgrade is not yet available.
