

Circular to Shareholders & Clerks: Wentworth & Selborne Chambers window and facade upgrade

February 22nd 2019

As a consequence of additional structural repairs that were required on the façade, there have been delays with progress. These delays have, unfortunately, extended the completion date by 3 weeks to 7 April 2019, subject to the Council and weather. The scaffold will be gradually dismantled in two portions in late March, where the final components of the cladding being installed as part of this process. Whilst the work is almost complete, the last components of the new facade are the most complicated to install and progress is necessarily slower now than before.

CCL appreciates Members' ongoing cooperation and understanding in relation to the disruption the work has caused. CCL Staff continue to be in close and regular contact with Clerks in anticipation of work being carried out or concentrated on particular Floors or areas.

Members please note:

- **Trades will continue to be present on the scaffold, performing work throughout the day, and as a consequence of their work they will be seen from and heard in Chambers.**
- **This is the final reminder to Members that the deadline to report defects is 28 February 2019.**
