Dear: Lockhart Members & Clerks,

I refer to my email of [11 October 2023](#) in relation to the proposed work by Optus Mobile Network to finalise the installation of the mobile tower on the roof of Lockhart Chambers. The final program is being completed, Optus have progressed the work and have advised CCL of a number of upcoming elements of work commencing next week including:

- A crane lift on the evening of Monday 13 November 2023 (or Wednesday 15 November 2023 as a secondary time slot) which will involve a partial closure of Macquarie Street and substantial changes and restrictions to parking conditions in the area.
- Construction of temporary access on the Lockhart roof on Tuesday 14 November, this is not expected to be noisy or disruptive.
- Rooftop surveys and structural preparation for the new towers later next week, where all noisy and disruptive work will be confined to Saturday and Sunday 18 & 19 November 2023.
- Installation of electrical cabling throughout Lockhart Chambers to power the new mobile site – over the coming weeks we anticipate that contractors will be present onsite during the day to undertake the cabling installation, they will be present on Floors but no noisy work will be undertaken during business hours.
- Power shutdown to the entire building (Lockhart Chambers), which will be scheduled after hours and most likely on a Saturday between now and the end of December to enable connection of the new cable. During this time, access to Lockhart Chambers will not be possible.
