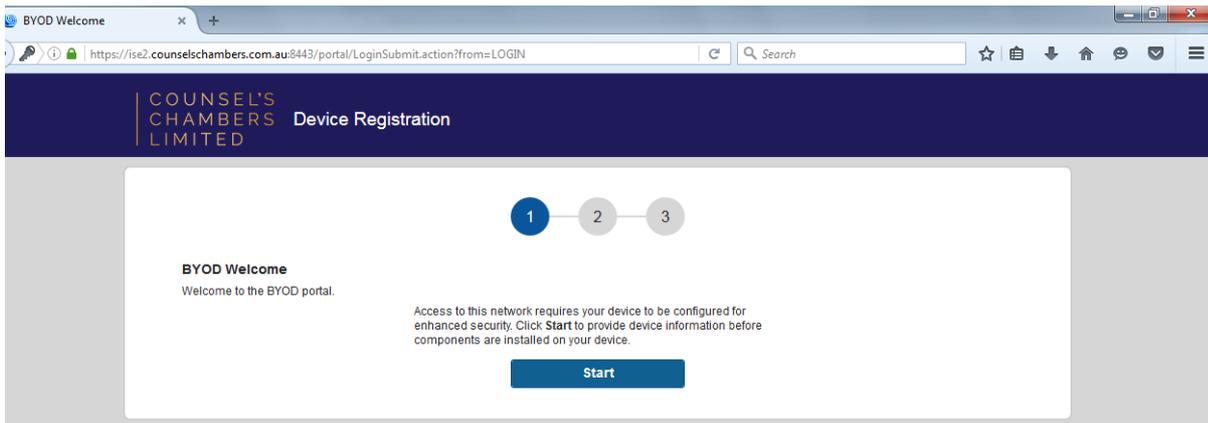


## Counsel's Chambers Limited Network Device Connection – Windows 7

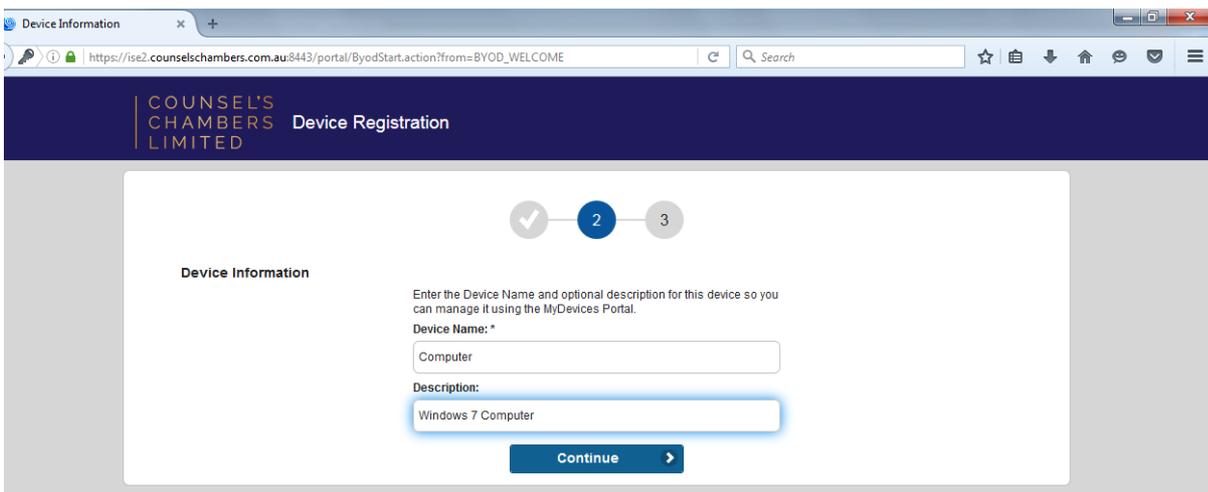
1. Connect the network port your PC to the PC port on your Cisco telephone handset
2. Open a browser (Firefox/Chrome/IE) and browse to [www.ccl.com.au](http://www.ccl.com.au). You will be redirected to the login screen **CCL Device Registration Portal**.
3. Login with your CCL Network username and password. If you do not know your password contact CCL support on 9221 6235 or email [support@ccl.com.au](mailto:support@ccl.com.au).

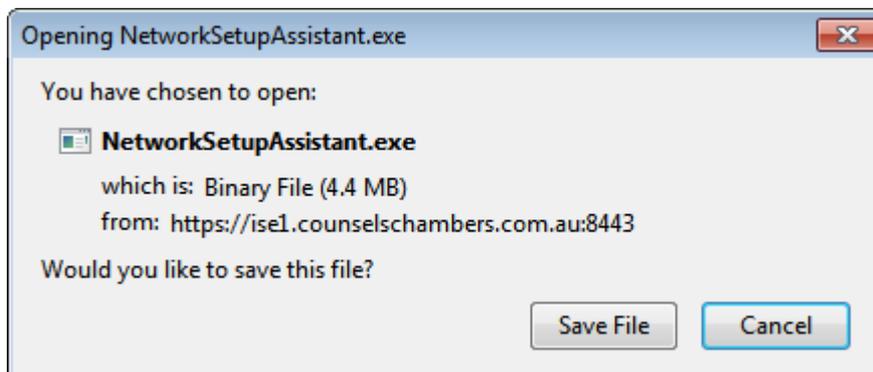
4. Press the **Start** button.



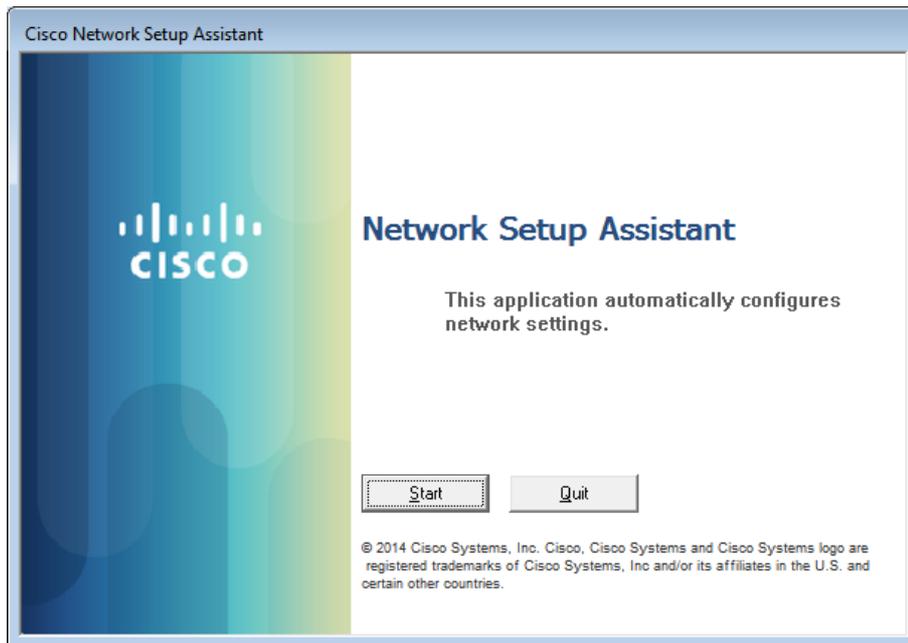
5. Enter a name and description for your computer.



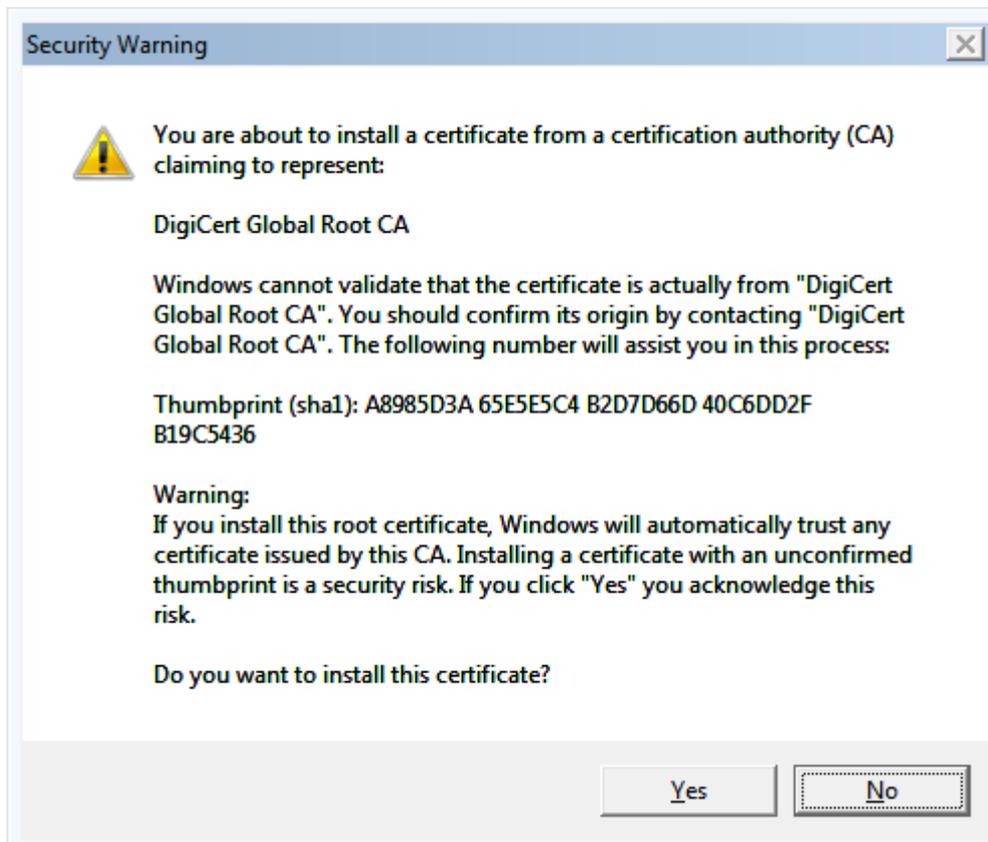
6. You will be prompted to download and run the **NetworkSetupAssistant.exe** tool. Save and run, or press “run” if given that option.



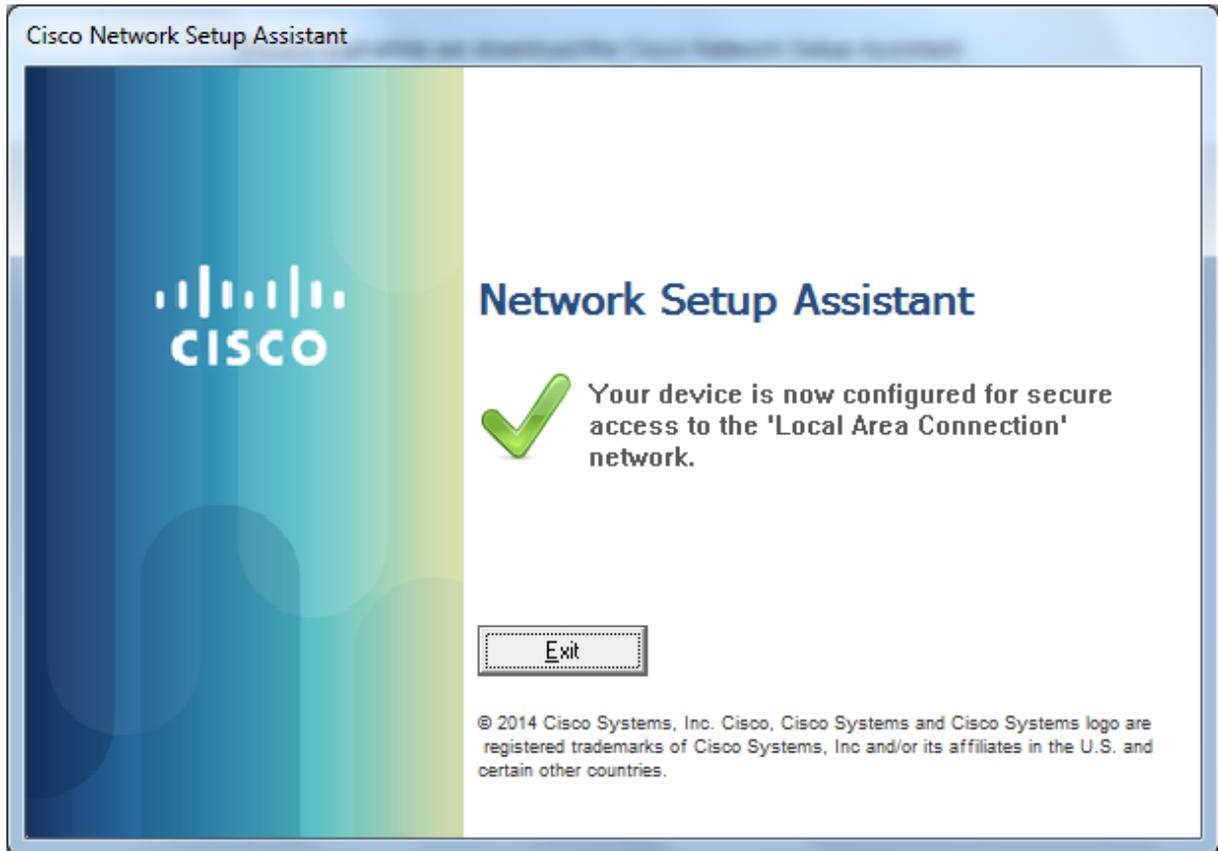
7. The **Cisco Network Setup Assistant** program will open. Press **Start**.



8. You will be prompted to install the **DigiCert Global Root CA** security certificate. For added security, check that the Thumbprint (SHA1) matches the one in the image below. Press **Yes**.



9. Your device is now able to connect to the CCL network.



10. The connection is complete, and your computer will automatically connect to the network.
