
4. Press the **Start** button.




6. You will be prompted to download and run the **NetworkSetupAssistant.exe** tool. Save and run, or press “run” if given that option.

8. You will be prompted to install the **DigiCert Global Root CA** security certificate. For added security, check that the Thumbprint (SHA1) matches the one in the image below. Press **Yes**.



9. Your device is now able to connect to the **CCL-Secure** Wireless network.



10. The connection is complete, and your computer will automatically connect to the **CCL-Secure** wireless network.
