<p>7. Navigate to the phone Settings and select Profile Downloaded, which should appear at the top of the settings screen.</p>	

<p>8. You will be taken to the Profiles section. Click on the Profile Service section.</p>	
<p>9. Press Install when prompted to install the profile service.</p> <p>You will be prompted to enter your device's PIN number if you have set one.</p>	
<p>10. Press Install to continue the installation process.</p>	
<p>11. Press Done. The profile has now been successfully installed.</p>	
<p>12. You will now need to forget the CCL-Connect network.</p> <p>Open the Wi-Fi settings and press the blue "i" icon next to CCL-Connect.</p>
